SCHEME:

NSFDC sponsors Skill Training for persons belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC) target group. The trainees are provided free training and stipend @Rs.1500/- per month in case of non-residential programs, subject to 90% attendance.

FOCUS:

- Adopt Integrated outcome based approach to fulfill skilling needs of target group & enhance their employability .
- Mobilize additional resources through CSR from Public/ Private Sector for skilling.
- Promote Learn Earn and Pay model of longer duration vocational courses.



