The Scheme of Residential Education for Students in High Schools in Targeted Areas (SHRESHTA) (Earlier known as Assistance to Voluntarily Organization working for Scheduled Cates (SCs) is being implemented by Department of Social Justice and Empowerment. The scheme is being implemented in two modes.

- 2. Under Mode-I of the SHRESHTA scheme, the list of eligible private residential schools is provided directly by the CBSE and there is no provision for the registration of any school independently under this mode.
