2. After Qualifying the Exam held by National Testing Agency, applications were invited by National Scholarship Portal for the candidate who have qualified in the YET 2022. Scholarship could be released to the applicants only after due verification by the designated Officers at the school/Institute level and State level and found eligible after following the due procedure.
