The undersigned is directed to say that it has been decided to fill up 01 post of Scientist-B (Chemical), General Central Service, Group-A (Gazetted) Non Ministerial in level-10 (RS. 56100-177500/-) of the pay matrix in the National Test House, a subordinate organization of Department of Consumer Affairs, by deputation (including short term contract) basis from the:-

(I) Officer under the Central Government or State Government or Union Territories administrations or Public Sector Undertakings or Universities or Recognized Research Institutions or semi Government or Autonomous bodies or Statutory Organizations:

(a) (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
(ii) with two years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in level 8 (Rupees 47,600-1,51,100) in the Pay Matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department : and

(b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:

(i) Master's Degree in Chemistry/Microbiology from a recognized University or Institute: and

(ii) One year's practical experience in chemical analysis of materials such as building materials, metals, ores and minerals, oil and fuels, food, water, paints etc. in a recognized laboratory or institute using instrumental methods of testing.

(c) (i) Bachelor of Engineering or Bachelor of Technology in Chemical Technology/Chemical Engineering from a recognized University or Institute: and

(ii) Two years' practical experience in chemical analysis of materials such as building materials, metals ores and minerals, oil and fuels, food, water, paints etc. in recognized laboratory or institute using instrumental methods of testing.

II. The departmental officer in feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

III. The period of deputation (including short term contract) including period of deputation (including short term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (including short term contract) shall be not exceeding **fifty six** years as on the closing date of the receipt of the applications.

IV. For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to the 1st January, 2016 or the date from which the revised level in the pay matrix based on the recommendation of 07th CPC has been extended shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding level in the pay matrix extended based on the recommendations of the said pay commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale pay into one grade with a common level in the pay matrix and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that level in the pay matrix is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
