Invitation of Applications for the National Awards for outstanding services in the field of Prevention of Alcoholism and Substance (Drug) Abuse, 2018.

The National Awards would be given on 26th June, 2018, on the occasion of "International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking".

In continuation of the earlier, advertisements dated 9.11.2017 and 20.12.2017 published in various News Papers, and this Ministry's website, applications are again invited for the National Awards for the outstanding services in the field of Prevention of Alcoholism and Substance (Drug) Abuse **under the category of Best Panchayati Raj or Municipal Body working for prevention of alcoholism and substance (drug) abuse**, due to lack of response in this category.

Procedure for Applications:

- (1) Application can be submitted by organizations/Institutions fulfilling the prescribed criteria. Criteria laid for each of the above category of awards and the details of the Scheme of National Awards, 2018 may be seen at <http://socialjustice.nic.in/writereaddata/UploadFile/NA636078226610282667.pdf>
- (2) The Applications should be in Hindi or English language only.
- (3) The following agencies or persons are authorized to nominate and recommend eligible institutions or individuals for the Awards:
 - (a) Concerned Ministries or Departments of the Government of India and their Autonomous Institutions with the approval of the Minister-in-charge of the Ministry.
 - (b) State Governments or Union Territory Administrations with the approval of the concerned Chief Minister or Lt. Governors in Union Territory Administrations.
 - (c) Regional Resource and Training Centres working in the field of drug de-addiction within their own jurisdiction - **Annexure-I.**
 - (d) Members of the National Consultative Committee on De-addiction Rehabilitation (NCCDR) - **Annexure-II.**
 - (e) Renowned Apex Chambers like Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry, Confederation of Indian Industry, The Associated Chambers of Commerce and Industry of India, etc.
 - (f) Past Awardees - **Annexure-III.**
 - (g) Organizations like University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Medical Council of India (MCI), Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS), Universities, Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti (NVS), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), etc; and

- (h) Collector of the District/District Magistrate in which the Institution or Individual is working.
- (i) Commissioner of Commissionerate in which the Institution or Individual is working.
- (4) Only nominations or recommendations emanating from Authorized Agencies or persons, designated for the purpose, supported by adequate justification, shall be considered.
- (5) Applications in the prescribed proforma should be sent to the Joint Secretary (SD), Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Room No. 616-A, 'A' Wing, Shatri Bhawan, New Delhi – 110001, latest by **31st May, 2018.**

Application received after the last date and/or not recommended by the prescribed authority/persons will not be entertained.
