**ORDER**

Whereas, the NGO namely Pawan Sewa Sansthan, Gonda, Uttar Pradesh has been receiving financial assistance from time to time from this ministry under the Scheme of Assistance to Voluntary Organisation working for Welfare of Scheduled Castes for running of Residential Primary School for SC Beneficiaries.

2. Whereas, the said NGO has executed bonds in favor of the President of India for the amount in the prescribed format bonding themselves jointly, severally to the terms and conditions in the event of the grantee failing to comply with the conditions committing breach of the conditions of the bond, the signatory to the bond shall be jointly and severally liable to re-fund President of India, the whole or a part amount of the grantee with interest at the rate of 10 percent per annum therein or the sum specified under the bond.

3. Whereas, the Grantee Organisation shall abide by the terms and conditions mentioned in the Sanction Order, provisions and guidelines of the Scheme of Grant-in-Aid to Voluntary Organisations working for Scheduled Castes, provisions of General Financial Rules, 2017, instructions issued by this Ministry and Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance from time to time and any subsequent revision/changes therein.

4. Whereas, the Government is not satisfied with the progress of the project considering that the guidelines of the Scheme, terms and conditions of the Sanction Orders issued by this Ministry, provisions of General Financial Rules 2017 etc, are violated. The motive of the NGO in establishing the School and the way it is run, leads to a lot of suspicions. The status of the school on ground is not in commensurate with the grants-in-aid received by the NGO.

5. Whereas, Government of India has caused an inspection conducted of Voluntary Organisation which is getting Grant-in-Aid from the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and the inspection team observed as under:-

- a) The infrastructure facilities were not at all commensurate with the requirements of a 100 student's residential school.
- b) There were only three classrooms and one of the class was being held in the lobby area. Classes for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> standard were being held jointly.
- c) It seems the NGO officials had prior information of the inspection. The team met Sh. L. P. Pandey (Chief functionary), the teachers & other staff.
- d) Out of 100 Students, 52 Students were present at the time of inspection.
- e) The hostel facilities and beds were not at all adequate for 100 students. Some of the student said they commute from home while some said they stay in the hostel.
- f) The learning level of the students was very poor. The students were not able to answer very simple questions.
- g) The knowledge level of the teachers (about the subjects they teach) was very low.
- h) We had the food prepared for the students for lunch. The taste was not good and the daal prepared was smelling of something.
- i) The kitchen of the school was not found in a good condition.
- j) The staircase leading up to the classrooms is dangerous, especially when children of even 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> standard have to climb up on them.



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- k) There were 3 toilets, which is not at all adequate for 100 students.  
l) Books and uniform had not been provided to the students up to now.

*It is clear that the scheme guidelines have been not followed*

6. Now, Keeping in view of all the above mentioned facts especially with regards to poor infrastructure and absence of the students, it has been decided by the competent authority in public interest to blacklist the NGO namely Pawan Sewa Sansthan for receiving further financial assistance in any form whatsoever under various Scheme of this Ministry. It is ordered accordingly.

7. This order is issued without prejudice to any other action that may be initiated against the NGO for their action of omission and commission, without any further reference in the matter.
