LIST OF NEW PROPOSALS UNDER THE SCHEME OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR PREVENTION OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE (DRUGS) ABUSE AND FOR SOCIAL DEFENCE SERVICES CONSIDERED BY THE SCREENING COMMITTEE IN ITS MEETING HELD ON 11th NOVEMBER 2016.

A meeting of the Screening Committee constituted by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment was held on 11th November, 2016 under the Chairmanship of Smt. Ghazala Meenai, Joint Secretary (Social Defence) to scrutinize and make recommendation on the new proposals of NGOs received through State Governments/Union Territories under the Scheme of Financial Assistance for Prevention of Alcoholism and Substance (Drugs) Abuse and for Social Defence Services. The members of the Committee Sh. S Prakash, Sh. Vivek Kabra and Shri Sandeep Gupta, Director (IFD) in the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment were present in the meeting. Shri Khagesh Garg, Director (DP) and Shri Rajesh Kr. Sinha, Under Secretary (DP) were asked by the Committee to assist in the scrutiny during the meeting.

- 2. Smt. Ghazala Meenai, Joint Secretary (Social Defence) and Chairman of the committee welcomed the members and drew the attention of the members to clause 3.4.2 (v) of the Scheme of Assistance for Prevention of Alcoholism and Substance (Drugs) Abuse and for Social Defence Services which entails that the organizations/institutions to be eligible should ordinarily have existed for three years. After detail deliberations, it was decided that the following parameters may be taken into considerations for recommending an organization to be eligible to receive grant from M/o Social Justice and Empowerment:
  - i. Equal geographical spread ensuring due considerations to un-served and underserved areas.
  - ii. Depiction of expenditure in the annual accounts
  - iii. Mention of the de-addiction in MOA.
  - iv. Normally not more than one NGOs in a district and three in a big city. For metropolitan, it was decided that a judicious view may be taken in each case as per addiction rate, number of available projects etc.
  - v. Activity of de-addiction requires focused attention to patients. It was therefore, decided that those organizations who are solely concentrating on de-addiction may be given preference to those who are undertaking multiple social activities.
- 3. The Committee, during examination of the proposals, observed a large number of new proposals recommended by the State Government were in existence for less than 3 years, which was not in consonance with the provision 3.4.2(v) of the Scheme. It was observed that many proposals were incomplete in many respects and therefore, did not find it possible to recommend these proposals. Many of the Projects had not reflected the activities with regard to de-addiction undertaken during previous years in their Annual Report and no substantial amount was incurred as per their Audited Accounts. Remarks against each have been mentioned against their names in the Annexure to this Minutes. It was also decided that before release of grant in aid to these NGOs, the Ministry may satisfy itself about their proper functioning through an inspection either by a team of officers from the Ministry or by the representatives of the RRTCs.

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- 4. The two external members of the Screening Committee suggested that they should be authorized to inspect the IRCAs. Shri Vivek Kabra recommended that since these IRCAs receive grant in aid from the Ministry, they should invariably display on their reception that treatment facilities provided by them to patients is free of cost. He also expressed concerned over increasing number of wine shop in Delhi and other parts of the country.
- 5. In total, seven proposals were recommended by the Committee for grant- in- aid and two IRCAs were recommended for up gradation from 15 bedded to 30 bedded. The state wise position of the new proposals placed before the Committee and its recommendations are given as under:
- (i) Assam: All the 2 new proposals and one discontinued case duly recommended by the State level GIA Committee and received through Govt. of Assam were placed before the Screening Committee for consideration. The Committee, on scrutinizing these proposals recommended following discontinued case for release of grant:
