NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. No. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Commission for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Group 'A' post) Recruitment Rules 1986, except as respect to things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **Deputy Inspector General of Police** in the National Commission of Scheduled Castes namely,

1. Short title and commencement:

- (1) These Rules may be called **the National Commission for Scheduled Castes (Deputy Inspector- General) Recruitment Rules, 2017'**.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application: These rules shall apply to posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and Pay Level in Pay Matrix: The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications, etc.: The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in column 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification: No person-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax:** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Saving:** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
